Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our students' Physical Education Curriculum for years 9, 10 and 11 it is necessary to teach some aspects of their courses at the Plymouth Life Centre. This has been normal practice at the school for many years.

The students will be registered in the Main Hall at school before being escorted over to the Life Centre by a member of the PE department. Please see below the times they will need to meet in the Main Hall for their lesson.

Period 2 – 10.05am  
Period 3 – 11.15am  
Period 4 – 12.30pm  
Period 5 – 2.15pm

If they have a lesson during Period 1 they should report directly to the Life Centre for registration at 08.50am, where they will met by a member of the PE department and **not** go to the main school. Students arriving early to school by bus should arrange to meet friends on the school site and walk across in groups. They will need to come to the Life Centre already changed into their PE Kit. For period 2 lessons they will need to come to the school in their PE kit, however, periods 3 or 4 they should change during break time. Those with a lesson period 5 will need to change during lunch.

All students will be escorted back to school by a member of the PE department unless their lesson is period 5. In this instance, students will be dismissed from the Life Centre at 3.20pm enabling them to meet transport home.
